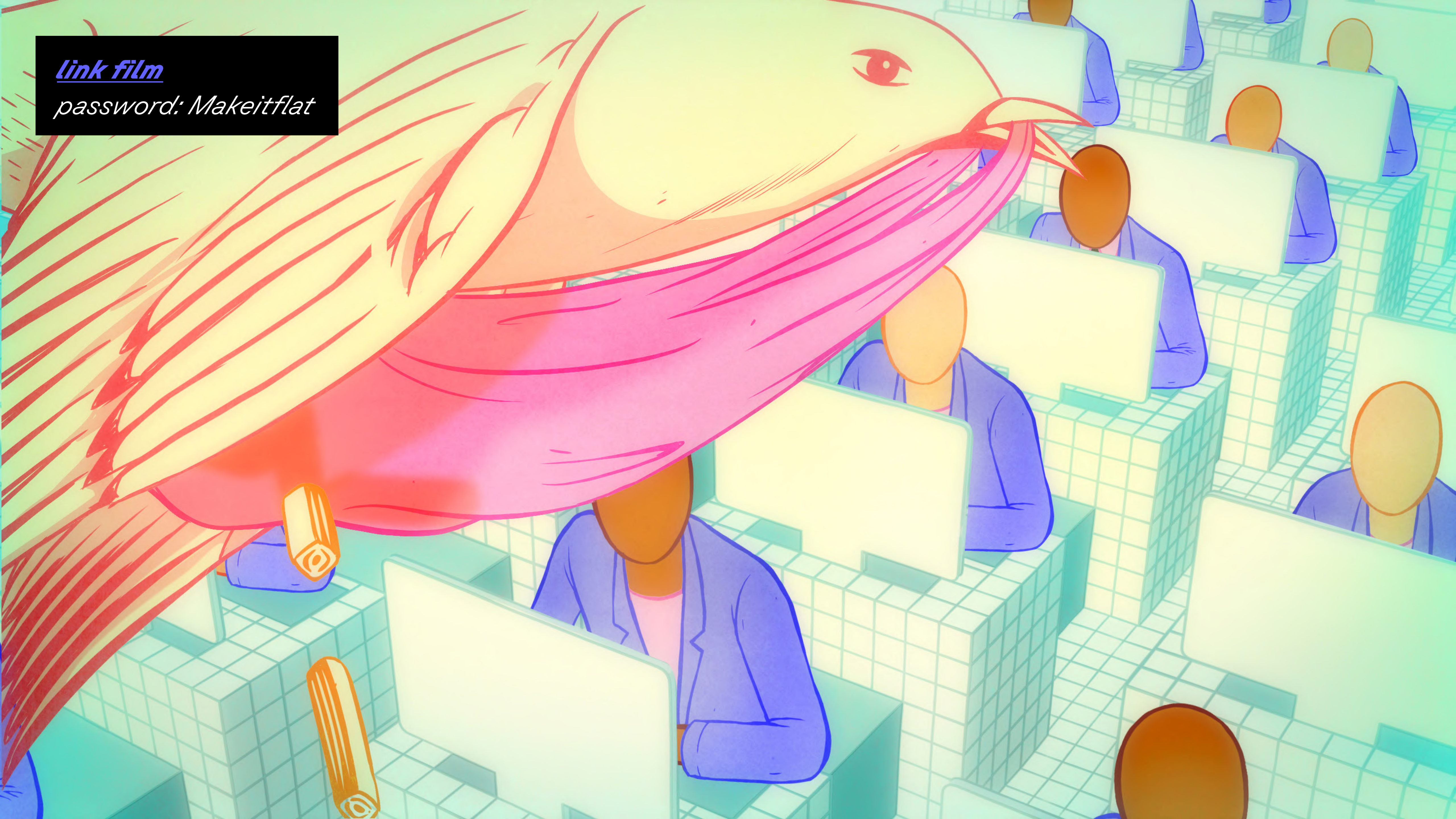

long synopsis

Factories belch out smoke, Humans are gorging on surimi sticks and take-away coffee cups, constantly filming themselves, commuting by hoverboard in the overpopulated and increasingly suffocating cities. But terrestrial opulence comes at a price, and in the depths underwater, the situation is critical.

When the Manta Rays discover yet another of their peers suffocated by a killer plastic bag, they rise up in revolt. A wave of insurgence against the Human race ensues. A tsunami of revolt submerges the spotless buildings and the organised shoals of Manta Ray commandos take control of the Earth. It is the beginning of the Flatastic Era.

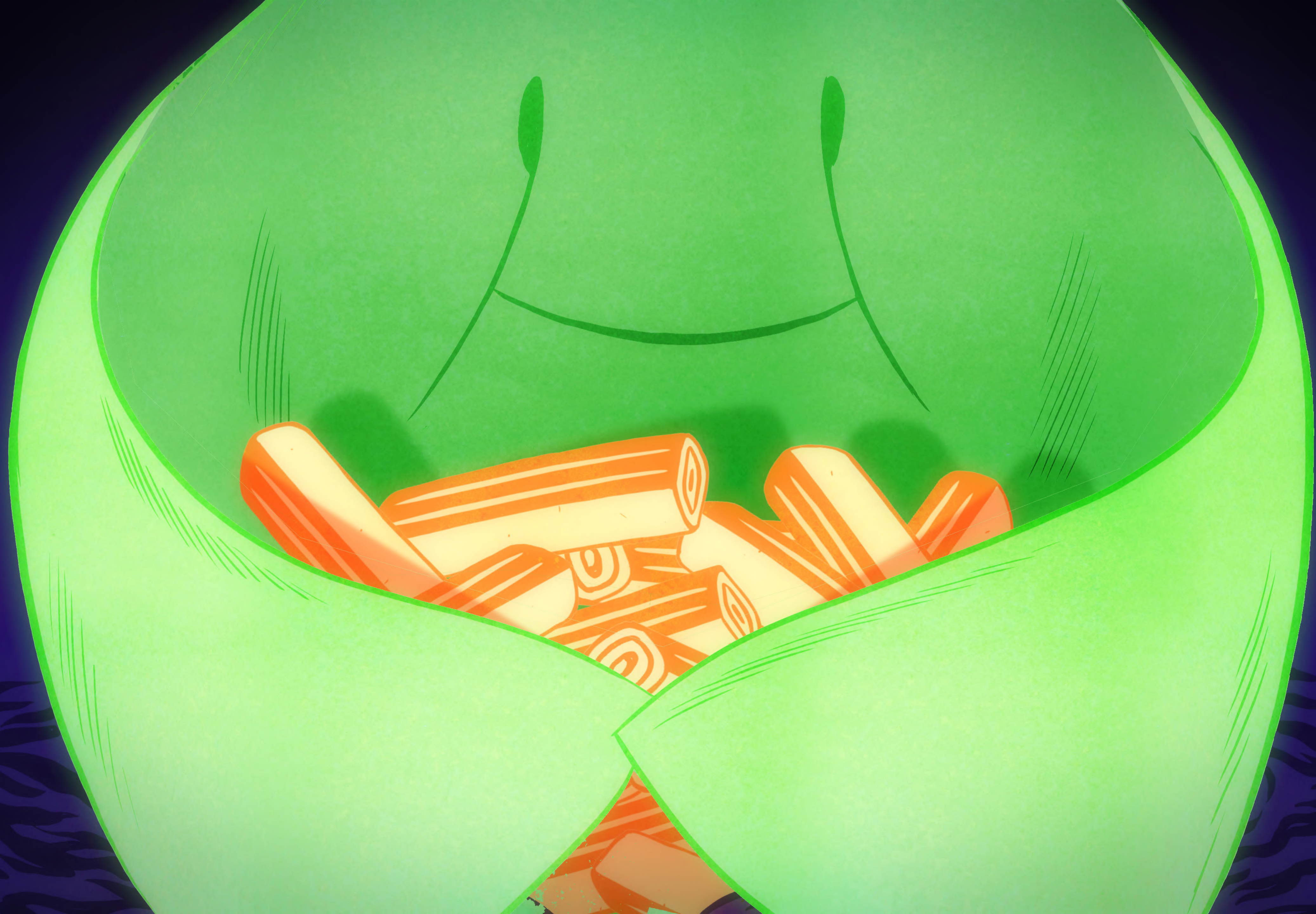
Armed with steamrolling smartboards, the Manta Rays chain-flatten humans with Taylorian professionalism, with the proud aim to shape them to their image. They also reorganize spaces; occupying the surface of the water and its floating buildings, the Rays navigate through synchronized swimming pools, experimentation laboratories, saunas... As for Humans, they have reinvented their lives in the depths, on the ruins of their lost world.

But in this new hierarchy of power, no one seems to perceive the warnings of the rumbling Earth...

director's statement

FLATASTIC is a silent, metaphoric and burlesque ballet. Our objective is to define an organisational framework of the different social groups and understand the reproductive mechanisms of domination and anthropomorphism, while calling into question the paradoxical fragility of our survival as a species.

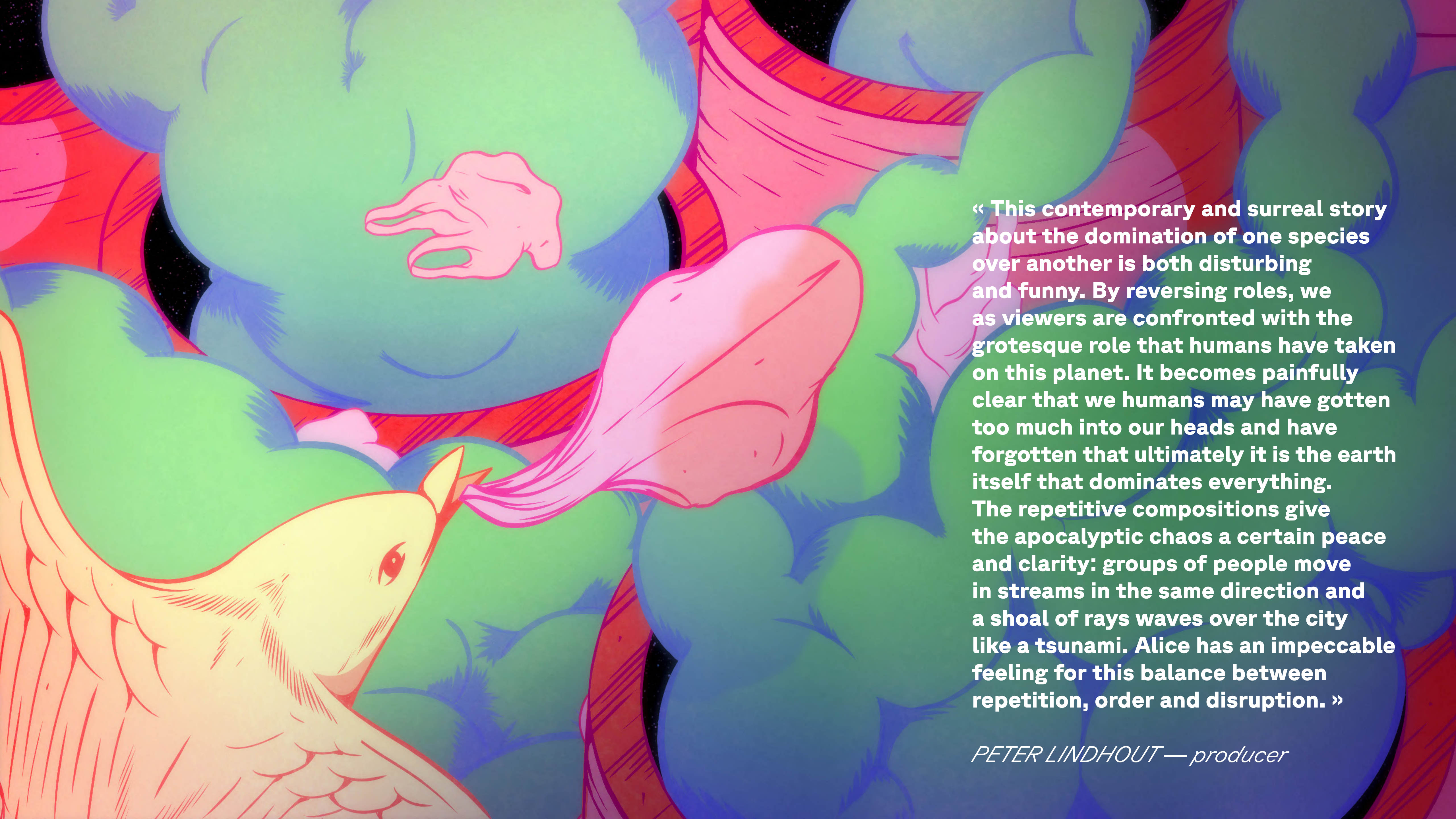
Mocked, abused, amputated, scorned, constrained and struggling to survive, the rays not only embody the tragic fate of non-human lives in our world but act as a metaphor of our own frustrations, as members of the younger generation.

The uprising of the Manta Rays is also our own to some extent. This systematic reproduction is what we often do despite our desire to try something new, being stuck in an antiquated imagery borrowed from sentiments that would be impossible to play out on a major scale, and to reinvent a fair and communal world.

The tone of Flatastic is one of comfortable malaise, at once disquieting and droll. By oscillating continuously between violence, humour and reverie, our aim is to be off-beat for the sake of embarrassing, while being playful and light hearted, turning the pathetic into the burlesque, and making the gross sublime. Similar to when the manta rays leap majestically out of the ocean only to fall flat on the surface of the water below.

« This contemporary and surreal story about the domination of one species over another is both disturbing and funny. By reversing roles, we as viewers are confronted with the grotesque role that humans have taken on this planet. It becomes painfully clear that we humans may have gotten too much into our heads and have forgotten that ultimately it is the earth itself that dominates everything. The repetitive compositions give the apocalyptic chaos a certain peace and clarity: groups of people move in streams in the same direction and a shoal of rays waves over the city like a tsunami. Alice has an impeccable feeling for this balance between repetition, order and disruption. »

director's biography



Alice Saey is a Franco-Scottish graphic artist and animation director. She draws with Indian ink, often in Paris, mostly in Rotterdam. Her work focusses on poetic and graphic forms of narration, in the fields of design and film.

Since she graduated from a graphic design Masters in HEAR (Strasbourg, FR) she animated naked ladies, dancing geese and singing volcanos in music videos ***SHE'S YOUNG*** (Shaking Godspeed), ***HAPPY*** (Mark Lotterman) and ***CAREFUL***

(Jo Goes Hunting), which collected over 20 awards and brought her work to international recognition. ***FLATASTIC***, written by Lea Perret and produced by Miyu Keplerfilm and Spotted Bird is her first professional short film. She has collaborated with various clients including Arte, Centre Pompidou, Socialter. She will also be drawing 20 m² of murals for the new metro station ***LA COURNEUVE — SIX ROUTES***, as a part of the Grand Paris Express project.

Next to her artistic practice, Alice enjoys taking part in the international animation discussion as a jury member and lecturer. She recently co-founded ***TINSEL***, a Rotterdam-based collective dedicated to the production of contemporary animation with fellow animation directors Wiep Teeuwisse and Nienke Deutz and In 2023 they started curating ***SHORTS FROM THE SECOND FLOOR***, a series of animation screenings in their studio, with the aim to strengthen the animation culture in their city.

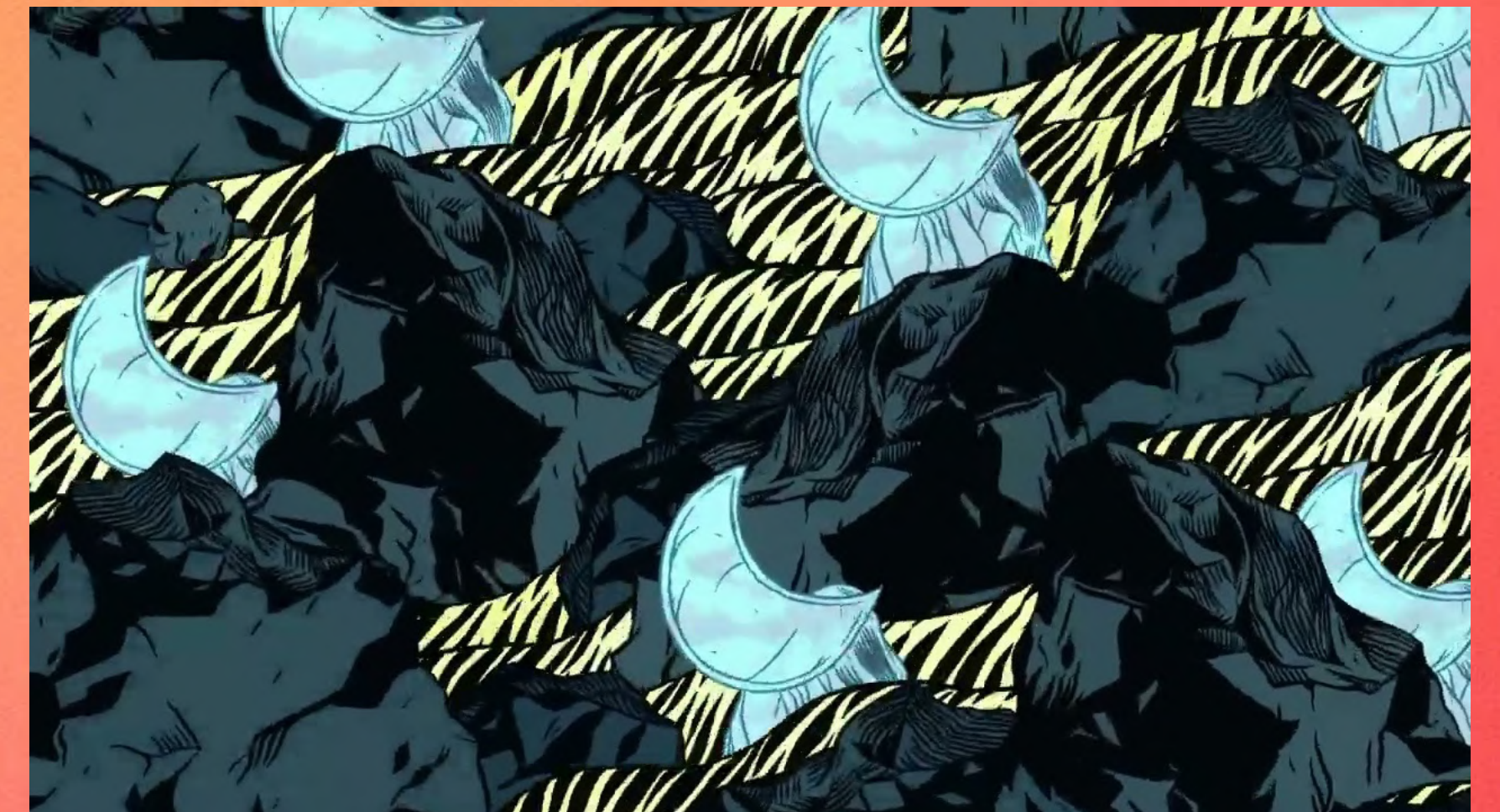

scriptwriter's biography



Lea Perret is an actress, author, and theatre director. She received training at the Conservatoire du XX^e, the Studio of Asnieres and the ERACM.

As an actress, she has worked under the direction of Giorgio Barberio Corsetti, Cyril Teste, Yan Allegret, Urszula Mikos, Aline Reviraud, Louise Brzezowska-Dudek, Agathe Charnet, Emma Perret, Cherifa Tsouri, Theo-Comby Lemaitre, and the performer Clara Vidal-Rosset.

Recently, she performed in ***QUE TOUT S'ENFLAMME, NOUS ATTENDRONS***, directed by Aline Reviraud, in ***SAUVAGES*** by Quentin Laugier, directed by Louise Brzezowska-Dudek, and in ***NIGHTSWIMMING*** by Romain Grard.

Passionate about anticipation, science, and sociology, she wrote, performed and directed ***LA FIN DU MONDE - RECREATION***, a science fiction comedy on transhumanism created at Theatre de La Loge in 2015. In 2021, she created ***L'HORIZON DES EVENEMENTS*** at Dieppe Scene Nationale, a piece exploring the paradox between the fantasy of true love and our contemporary inability to deeply connect with each other in a society influenced by personal development trends. In 2024, she will create ***INTIME ET COLLECTIF - FACE A***, a socio-economic-political-ethical-historical perspective on our romantic failures, written and performed in collaboration with Louise Brzezowska-Dudek. She is currently working on the second part of the dyptic, ***FACE B***, and a solo performance, ***WELCOME TIME TRAVELLERS***, a show on ufology. ***FLATASTIC*** is her first short film script.

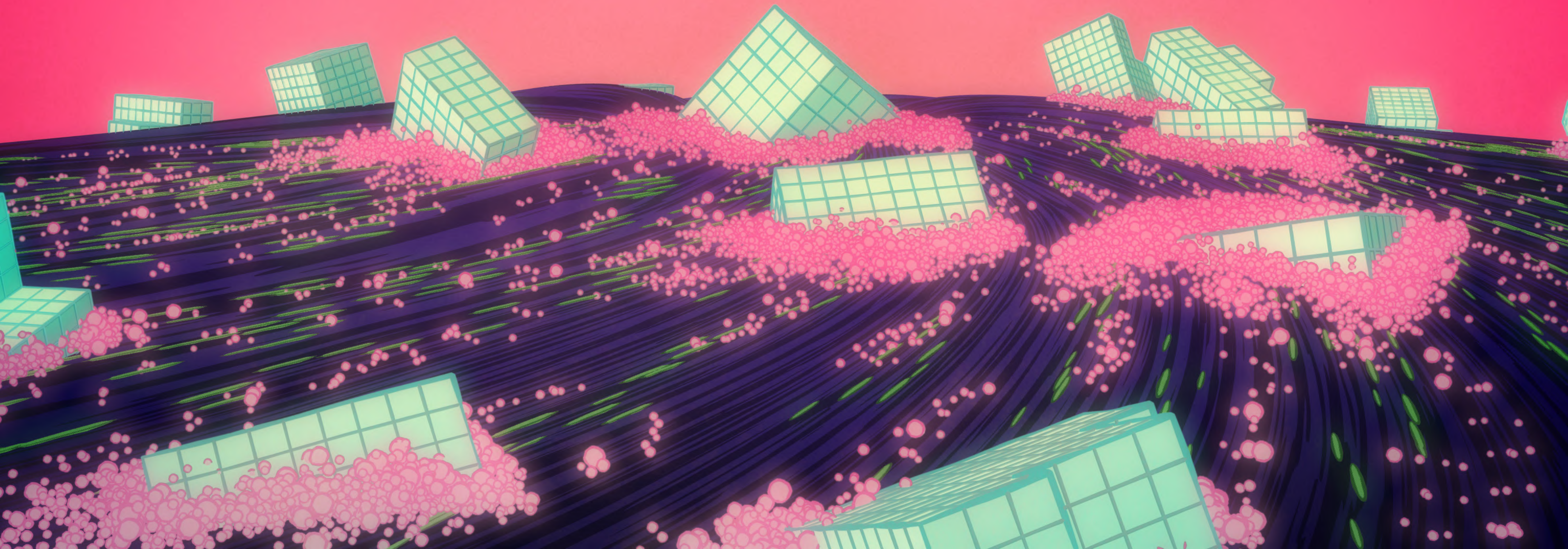
