Synopsis

Throughout *There Once Is* we encounter a Little Sunhat Bolo Boy, a Bluebeard man, a Wolf on a motorcycle, a duck that lays golden eggs, three little pigs, and many more characters whom we think we know already, but turn out to be different than expected. Seeing as these tales cross both centuries and horizons, this series is an opportunity for a colourful present-day voyage. So fasten your seatbelts, we are ready for take-off!

Key Points

The irreverent humour of the general tone. Each episode will be a humoristic revision of a classic tale, tinged with insolence and absurdity.

The extremely modern visuals and Camille de Cussac's joyful style will bring contemporary social themes to the stage.

An urban aesthetic and the present-day setting will shape the general context of the series. (For example, the story of *Little Red Riding Hood* no longer takes place long ago in the forest, but in the suburbs of a town in the present-day.)

The geographical locations will be different for each episode, meaning that each setting will be fresh and original.

Situational comedy will come into play with the revisions of each land's local traditions, where the action of each episode takes place.

The direction will be "pop" and filled with Camille de Cussac's visual compositions and colours. The narration will be tight to create a fast pace, maximise humour, situational comedy and give way to a burst of youth.

Patrick Volve

Patrick Béraud - AKA Volve - was born in France in 1972. He studied audio-visual media to become a sound engineer, specialising in post-production for animated films.

In 1997, he participated in the creation of the collective "La Lueur Déchirée" with which he directed multiple experimental Super 8 films.

In 2000, with other associates, he founded the production company Metronomic, for which he directed more than twenty music videos as well as the educational series "Patrimonito's World Heritage Adventures" for UNESCO.

In 2010, he directed the imagery for the play "ROSA LA ROUGE" directed by Marcial di Fonzo Bo with Claire Diterzi.

In 2011, he wrote and directed "DANS LE NEZ : La Romantique des fluids" a short film broadcast on Canal+.

In 2014, he directed his second short film "BUBBLE BLUES" which was selected for over 20 festivals, won numerous awards and was broadcast by Canal+.

In 2018, he directed the animated series LITTLE MALABAR with the production company Tchack, in association with France Télévision. (26x4').

He is currently directing the second season of this series and, in parallel, is developing the animated series TILT, co-written with the actor Esteban for the production company Tchack.

Have a Nice Day

Created in December 2020 by Émilie Djiane, former director of cinema distribution and Denis Walgenwitz, expert in the production of animated films, HAVE A NICE DAY is an independent audiovisual production group from Lille specializing in animation.

Miyu Productions

Created in May 2009 by Emmanuel-Alain Raynal, joined in 2015 by Pierre Baussaron, Miyu Productions is an audiovisual and cinematographic production company specializing in animation which produces short films, series and feature films.

Miyu Productions has built over the years the image of a demanding animation studio through its artistic line and its commitment, particularly through its production of animated short films. Several of our films have been recognized and awarded in the most prestigious festivals, including 27 by Flóra Anna Buda, winner of the Palme d'Or and the short film Cristal at the Cannes and Annecy festivals in 2023, as well as our feature films, unique in the landscape of contemporary production, (Chicken for Linda! by Chiara Malta and Sébastien Laudenbach, feature film Cristal film in Annecy in 2023). The company was awarded the French Film Animation Trophy in 2019 and received the Procirep prize from the French animation producer in 2022.

The company is currently developing a portfolio of around ten feature films, around twenty short films and several series and audiovisual units, and has 4 production studios in France located in Paris, Valence, Angoulême and Marseille and a studio in Belgium which will soon open its doors in Brussels.

Miyu Distribution

By joining forces in 2017 with Luce Grosjean, Miyu launched Miyu Distribution.

Specializing in international sales and distribution of animated short films, the company distributes all of Miyu Productions' short films, graduation films from major animation schools as well as films from independent production structures.

Five films from his catalog have been nominated for Oscars.

In 2020, Miyu Distribution was awarded the prize for best French distribution company awarded by UniFrance and the Festival of Court Film.

Miyu Gallery

Continuing its editorial line, Miyu opened in April 2022 at 101 rue du Temple in Paris, the first art gallery in the world dedicated to the arts and techniques of animation.

It's aim is both to offer a space to promote the plastic and visual work of animation filmmakers, but also to include animated techniques in the history of contemporary art.

The gallery also aims to be open to everyone and will be a place of creation and meeting for artists in the field of contemporary creation who would like to use animation techniques for their works through the creation of a residency dedicated to animation in partnership with Frac Picardie and support in production and demonstration.

MIYU thus becomes a global label to disseminate and reflect the talent of global independent animation filmmakers.


From One Painting To Another
