DIRECTORS' NOTE

Le Jardin Rossini was born from a shared intention: telling an original and intimate story through a unique visual universe. We chose to focus on Herve's point of view -the father's- to explore an unusual perspective and to answer meaningful questions about legacy and identity.

Our movie is centered around the theme of transmission: what do we leave to our loved ones? How can we trust what they will do with our legacy? How to let go of our expectations? These questions guide our main character, Hervé, throughout the film.

Our relationships to our elders move us deeply and we hope you will witness and recognise a sincere moment between Hervé and Rosalie.



SYNOPSIS

Hervé, 80 years old, is a famous artist: through his garden he creates ever-evolving and surrealistic landscapes. Tonight, he is hosting his last exhibition, during which he will reveal under the pearl willow his final master piece.

Hervé catches sight of his daughter Rosalie through the crowd, just as she is about to leave. As he is trying to convince her to stay, they are interrupted by pearls slipping past their feet. The pearl willow is shedding its pearls - it needs to be repaired. Hervé persuades Rosalie to stay and help. What follows is a lovely journey through the garden.

Hervé and Rosalie finally reach the willow and start weaving the pearls back onto the branches, sharing a moment together. Suddenly, a branch snaps again, scattering dozens of pearls across the ground. As Rosalie stoops to gather the fallen jewels, she realizes the branches were deliberately cutby Hervé himself! Before she can confront him, Hervé is already on stage in front of the crowd, revealing his final masterpiece: his own grave. He announces his own death and declares that his daughter will inherit the garden - then catches her off guard by drawing back the curtain to reveal her. Shocked and furious, Rosalie storms off the stage. Trapped by his own theatrics, Hervé is forced to bury himself to the cheers of the audience.

But is he really dead? Tormented by how things turned out, Hervé tosses and turns in his grave. Unable to bear it any longer, he climbs out, determined to talk to his daughter. Outside, the crowd is gone and the garden is in disarray. Only Rosalie remains, stacking her last suitcases into a hot-air balloon. During their conversation, Hervé realizes that his daughter is taking a piece of the garden - and therefore a part of him - with her. They share a final, emotional goodbye. Rosalie floats away into the distance, while Hervé returns to his grave, at peace.
